**ORDER**

The Director of Fisheries as per the letter read above, furnished the project proposal for Basic Infrastructure facilities and Human Development of Fisherfolk (Rehabilitation) with a total cost of Rs.150 Crore under the Head of Account 4405-00-103-93 and has requested to issue Administrative Sanction for the same in the current financial year.

(2). As per the GO read above, Finance department had directed to plan cut of 20% of total plan proposal amount of fisheries department.

(3). Based on this, the Director of Fisheries furnished the revised project proposal of Basic Infrastructure Facilities for fisherfolk (BIF) for Rs. 78.20 crore after finalising the 20% plan cut under the head of account 4405-00-103-93(P) and has requested to issue Administrative Sanction for the same in the current financial year under the scheme Basic Infrastructure Facilities and human development of fisher folk with the following components.

**(4). Output & Outcome**

- 92 flat apartments were constructed for 772 families.
- The project promotes socio-economic and cultural development of fisher folk.

(5). Considering the decision of the Special Working Group held on 7.01.2019, Government are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the project "Rehabilitation of fisherfolk" for an amount of Rs. 78.20 crore (Rupees Seventy Eight Crore Twenty lakh only) under the head of account 4405-00-103-93(P) under the scheme "Basic infrastructure facilities and Human Development of fisherfolk" in the state budget for the financial year 2018-19.

**(6). The following General conditions should be followed wherever applicable.**

- The fund release will be based on actual requirement and the fund released should not be parked in banks.
- Stores Purchase Rules shall be strictly adhered to.
- Tender/e-tender and other stipulated formalities shall be followed wherever necessary.
- For civil works, CPWD rates shall be followed.
- Post creation and purchase of vehicles are not admissible under the scheme.

(7). The Director of Fisheries will take further necessary action in this matter.
