Ojectives

- 1. To survey the fishery resources potential and generation of data base;
- 2. To analyze the water quality of the selected area;
- 3. To conduct training programmes on various aquaculture practices and fish processing.
- 4. To conduct demonstrations on diversified aquaculture practices and allied sectors viz.freshwater fish farming, brackish water fish farming, cage culture pen culture, ornamental fish culture, preparation of value added fishery products etc. in suitable water bodies;
- 5. To study the replicability and scope for up-scaling of the project

components.

- 6. Capacity building and Skill development among the undergraduate students.
- 7. Provide practical field exposure to the students on various aspects of Aquaculture and allied activities.
- 8. Create and enrich entrepreneurship capabilities.
- 9. Develop attitude for team work and dignity of labour.
- 10. Market surveys and production plan for small scale projects.
- 11. Develop competitive marketing capabilities utilizing common amenity center/sale counter.
- 12. Integration of various production activities like aquaculture, agriculture, aquaponics, poultry, fish processing etc.
- 13. Personality development and leadership.
- 14. Keeping students engaged and thus avoiding distractions.
- 15. Enable students to effectively carryout the Student READY program and student project as per the Vth Deans committee report.

5. An amount of ₹740 Lakh has been provided in the annual plan 2019–20 for the University with the objective to develop the Administrative, Education and Extension activities of the University.

6. The Special Working Group in its meeting held on 06.08.2019 discussed the proposal in detail and approved the same.
