ORDER

1. As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Chief Engineer, Harbour Engineering Department has submitted a proposal to strengthen the damaged breakwater at Thangassery at an estimated amount of Rs. 200 lakh. The main objective of the proposal is to strengthen the damaged breakwater at Thangasserry from Ch.1600 m to 1655 m in which nearly 555 No. of Tetra pods are required for enabling double layer protection at specified Chainages and requested to issue Administrative Sanction for the same.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative sanction for the proposal to strengthen the damaged breakwater at Thangassery at an estimated amount of Rs. 200 lakh (Rupees Two crore only) by meeting the expenditure under the head of account
