**ORDER**

As per the letter read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, Government of India had accorded Administrative approval for the project “Re-circulatory Aquaculture System” under the scheme Blue Revolution. As per the letter read 2<sup>nd</sup> above, the Director of Fisheries has furnished the Proposal for administrative sanction. The total cost of the project is Rs. 772.50 lakh, out of which Government of India share is Rs. 185.4 lakh and the remaining amount of Rs.137.1 lakh can be met by the State Government and Rs. 450 lakh by the beneficiary. The Central and State Share of Rs. 322.5 lakh can be met from the Head of account '2405-00-103-77 (P)' under Blue Revolution scheme. The Director has also informed that it is a continuing scheme without any change in unit cost and pattern of assistance.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for the project of “Re-circulatory Aquaculture System” for an amount of Rs.322.5 Lakh(Three crore Twenty Two lakh and Fifty Thousand only) from the Head of Account '2405-00-103-77(P)' under Blue Revolution scheme.
