ORDER

As per the letter read as 1st paper above, the Director of Fisheries has submitted a proposal, for providing free ration for 52 days in order to support the workers of the mechanized boats and allied workers including peeling workers during the trawl ban period 2026 and has requested sanction for Rs.30 lakh (Rupees Thirty lakh only) from the Head of Account 2405-00-121-95 (NP), for implementation of the proposal.

2) Objectives of the proposal are as follows:

1. To provide relief to the workers of mechanized boats and allied workers including peeling workers, who lose employment during the period of ban on bottom trawling.
2. To relieve the fishermen from the exploitation of money lenders.
3. To give nutritional support to the family of fishermen and allied fish workers.

3) Government have examined the proposal in detail and are pleased to accord Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.30 lakh (Rupees Thirty lakh only) under the Head of Account 2405-00-121-95(NP), for providing free ration to the workers of mechanised boats, peeling workers and allied workers in the fishing harbours during trawl ban period 2026.
