As per the letter read above, the Director of Fisheries has furnished a proposal for the project 'Theeronnathi' at an estimated cost of Rs.399.83 Lakh and has requested that administrative sanction be accorded for the same.

2) The objectives of the scheme are as follows :-

- To streamline and strengthen the activities of Fishermen co- operative societies.
- To provide assistance to fishermen and allied workers for continuation of treatment of fatal diseases.
- For creating awareness against drugs among the fishermen community.
- For conducting Medical camp in coastal villages to support the health status of fishermen.
- For providing skill development activities and thus by creating job opportunities to fishermen youth.

3) The fishermen who have registered with FIMS will be the direct beneficiaries.
