As per the letter read above, the Director of Fisheries has furnished the proposal for "Enhancement of Inland Fish Production by way of Conservation & Management of Aquatic Resources" with a total cost of the project of Rs.400 lakh under the Head of Account 2405-00-101-62-34-3(P) from the State budget provision for the financial year 2024-25 and has requested sanction for the same.

The objectives of the projects are detailed below:

- To manage the inland fish resources.
- To enhance fish production by effective surveillance, establishing fish protected area and ranching.
- To develop a management plan for the conservation of inland fishery resources.
- To provide livelihood security to inland fishermen sustainably.
- To uplift the socio-economic condition of fishermen.
- To ensure the availability of quality fish to public.

The project will be implemented in the major Backwater Aquatic Ecosystems and also in the inland water bodies of the state. The fishermen involved in fishing from inland water bodies are the direct beneficiaries. The allied fish workers and the fish consumers will be the indirect beneficiaries.
