### **ORDER**

The Director of Fisheries as per the letter read above has furnished the Project Proposal "Alternative and Supportive Livelihood opportunity to Fisher women of Kerala" for an amount of Rs.1400.00 lakhs for the period 2024-25, under the Head of Account 2405-00-103-80 (P) from the State Plan Fund implementing through Department of Fisheries in association with Society for Assistance to Fisher women (SAF) and has requested Administrative Sanction for the same.

- 2) The main objective of this project is to promote integrated sustainable development by training the fisher women to be engaged in other than fishing activities, which help them to secure their economic condition in the fishing community. Currently around 1600 micro enterprises are actively working under five different major categories across Kerala viz., Fish & Fish Processing, Food & Food Processing, Textile & Garments, Supermarket & Retail Stores, Services & Others. The objectives of the project is as follows:
  - To establish micro enterprises across the project area, directly benefiting 500 fisher women.
  - To provide a sustainable working capital assistance through revolving fund to assist 200 working fisher women by forming joint liability

groups, so as to meet their short-term working capital requirements

- To promote women micro enterprises in more sectors according to the choice of the entrepreneur and feasibility of the enterprise.
- To conduct necessary business development programs and skill training programs for the new and existing beneficiaries under SAF.
- To promote the sale of products of micro entreprises through a well-designed e- marketing channel and brand name.
- Catering holistic development of fisher women under community wellness interventions.
- To strengthen the Apex & Category Federations that cater to the online marketing and sales of SAF products.
- To help in earning a minimum of 10000/- per month for a beneficiary by enhancing sustainable development of their enterprise by proving financial, technical and marketing support.
- To establish a suitable mechanism so that the fisher women will be able to access institutional credit and prevent the exploitation by private money lenders.
- To provide livelihood opportunities to fisher women to ensure gender mainstreaming
