ORDER

As per the letter read above, the Director of Fisheries has furnished the proposal for "Kerala Reservoir Fisheries Development Project (KRFDP)" with a total cost of the project of Rs.100 lakh under the Head of Account 2405-00-101-51-34-3(P) from the State budget provision for the financial year 2024-25 and has requested Administrative sanction for the same.

The objectives of the projects are detailed below:

- To conserve and manage reservoir fisheries with the help of scientific tools;
- To ensure optimum utilisation of reservoir for fisheries development;
- To enhance the fish stock for augmenting fish productivity;
- To sustain the livelihood of fishermen;
- To generate additional employment opportunity and income to fishermen;
- To reduce poverty among reservoir fishermen;
- To uplift the socio-economic status of fishermen;
- To address protein deficiency among tribal settlements;
- To ensure the availability of quality fish to public;
- To record the fish catch and sales realisation accurately.

Fish stock enhancement programme will be implemented in 12 reservoirs with seeds of endemic fishes/carp. The fishermen/tribes residing around the reservoir area will be the direct beneficiaries of the project and they will be organized into Fishermen co-operative society. Allied fish workers and consumers of fresh water fishes will be the indirect beneficiaries.
