## <u>ORDER</u>

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to accord administrative sanction for Rectification of Transit shed at Seaward wharf at Vizhinjam for an amount of Rs. 21,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakhs Only) by debiting the expenditure from the Head of Account "5051-02-200-82-Vizhinjam Cargo Harbour", subject to the condition that the total cost of ongoing and new works sanctioned by different levels in the current year does not exceed 150% of the budget provision under the respective heads of accounts. The work shall be done through PWD/Accredited agencies/e-tender in a transparent manner as per norms under relevant Government orders in force.
