### ORDER

As per the letter read as 1<sup>st</sup> above, the Director of Fisheries has submitted a proposal for the project 'Group Personal Accident Insurance Scheme for Fish allied workers' at an estimated cost of Rs.118 Lakh and requested to issue administrative sanction for the same.

2) The objectives of the scheme are as follows :-

1. To provide social security to Fish Allied Workers and their dependents.
2. To cover the risk due to accident while engaged to fishery work leading to death, permanent disability, partial disability etc.

3) All Allied workers registered with Kerala Fishermen's Welfare Fund Board between the age of 18 to 70 will be the beneficiaries of the scheme.The implementation agency of the project is Kerala Fishermen Welfare Fund Board.
