As per the letter read as 1st above, the Director of Fisheries has submitted a proposal for the project 'Functioning of Sea Rescue and Disaster Management, Co-ordination & Information Centres & Formation of Harbour based Sea Rescue Squad' at an estimated cost of Rs.250 Lakh and requested to issue administrative sanction for the same.

2) The components of the scheme are as follows :-

1. Formation of Harbour based Sea Rescue Squad units and their functioning.
2. Revalidation of SAR (Search and Rescue) Certificates issued by the National Institute of Water Sports to the sea rescue squad personnel previously trained by the Department.
3. Functioning of SAR Control rooms.
